



Hydrant use at BGUA office

Permit: You need a permit from the BGUA office to use the hydrant. The cost of the permit varies depending on usage (i.e., one day, seasonal, construction). The permit can be viewed and downloaded from our website www.bgua.org.

Hours: The hydrant at the BGUA office can be used from 8:00am-4:00pm during the week (no use on weekends or holidays). Open season is considered April 1-November 14.

Location: The only hydrant to be used is located at The BGUA office. The hydrant is located in a roundabout off the main entrance.
